

Dividing Andhra Pradesh By Gautam Pingle

With the proposed trifurcation of the State of Andhra Pradesh, it is useful to look at the financial and other outcomes. On 21 March 2007, then Finance Minister (and later Chief Minister) K. Rosaiah, replying to a question in the Assembly, gave the breakup of revenue and expenditure over the previous four years (2003-07) for the three regions. These are the latest figures available till date.

He did not quite compare with the aspiration of the question, and a large chunk of revenue and expenditure was attributed to a fourth category - Headquarters. Without specifying what this entity represented, Rosaiah's response is less than candid and does not make sense - unless, of course, the idea is to show Hyderabad as a separate political entity in the future, then Hyderabad revenues will be larger than any of the three regions!

To complicate matters further, another column was added: 'revenues from other States'. To mak e matters simple, we need to add it to the ambiguous category. This combined 'Headquarters' income and expenditure may be allocated to the three regions on the basis of population between Andhra, Rayalaseema and Telangana - that is, in the ratio of 40:20:40.

The results for the average of three years (2003-06) balance between revenues and expenditure is given below. It needs to be borne in mind that these figures exclude Central Plan funds and devolution from the Finance Commission.

Conclusions: The table indicates that a new State, Telangana has almost viable finances as it generates a large surplus of revenues over expenditure. These surpluses when invested in Telangana would then ensure a vibrant economy based on agriculture, irrigation (especially the much-neglected tank irrigation) and industry and not just on real estate and services.

Hyderabad metropolis will act as a growth hub and a magnet for Telangana development. Without it, Telangana will not be able to attract state and national industries and population, especially from Andhra with its large educated and entrepreneurial population, massive river delta areas of the Krishna and

Godavari, and the gas fields around off-shore areas are viable future if it mobilizes its taxation revenue and applies it to industry.

Itamainaports, Visakhapatnam, Kakinada and Krishnapatnam are ill-served as hubs for the increasing foreign trade of the southern region. Visakhapatnam will prove ideal as much needed access to central India and southern Orissa.

Nellore with its proximity to Madras has a great locational advantage for industry having access to the metropolitan and airports. Its agriculture is highly developed - the two Deltas have provided extensive irrigation for over 150 years and there is a cumulative of private capital available to apply in diverse places which could be directed to the region itself. The Guntur-Vijayawada conglomeration will serve as its capital.

The problem is less favourable for Rayalaseema, which will need a central assistance to a greater extent than the other two regions as it is finance-starved and stabilised. It has after all only half the population of the two other regions while it is geographically large, it is relatively small in terms of productive workforce.

However, it has extensive mineral resources and the prime location of Anantapur, Chittoor and Kurnool districts within reach of the three major metropolises - Bangalore, Madras and Hyderabad - will ensure prosperity to them. Cuddapah town can easily become a capital, having access to the Canal and the Tunga-Ganga, and it will generate its own growth through district allocation of state resources from Krishna and Godavari rivers earlier awards to each of the new states will be done by a commission.

In political terms, the trifurcation would give the Congress Party a major edge (with the proposed merger of TRS) in Telangana State, where the dominant Reddy and Velama caste is numerically but manageably exercised influence disproportionate to their size because the now prosperous backward caste groups have not been able to align themselves.

Rayalaseema State would, as usual, see a battle between the Reddy groups in the Congress and YSR Congress. However, the TDP would also be a major actor in Rayalaseema and the YSR Congress in Coastal Andhra. But the picture is basically unpredictable as the situation is unique and only revealed in the 2014 General Election. Only the Congress in Telangana seems certain to dominate the new state.

As far as the Coastal Andhra people are concerned, they have skills, capacities and drive that will ensure whatever happens they and the state will do well economically and be one of the foremost in the country.

This will be especially once they devote their energies and capital to developing the region further. There does not seem to be any popular feeling on the issue of separation except that a general dissatisfaction with the whole matter.
